TO : All Steamship Agents, Owners, and Operators

**SUBJECT: LOCKS LANE OUTAGE AND PANAMA CANAL AUTHORITY
TRANSIT RESERVATION SYSTEM (REVISION No. 1)**

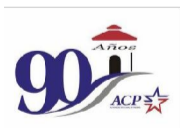
Based on present and projected number of vessels awaiting Canal transit, and in accordance with the rules governing the Transit Reservation System (MR's Notice to Shipping No. N-7-2004), Condition 3 will be in effect at 0001 hours, June 8, 2004 and continuing until further notice. Reservations previously accepted will be honored. Restoration of reservations under a less restrictive condition will be reassessed as transit backlog decreases.

As prescribed by the Panama Canal Regulations, the higher reservation fee will be applied to all vessels that make a reservation and transit while Condition 3 is in effect. Vessels that have reserved a transit slot before Condition 3, will retain the tariff in effect at the time the reservation was made.

This document is cancelled for record purposes on June 30, 2004.
