**ANNEX G: PERSON IN CHARGE OF SAFETY AND HEALTH FOR CONTRACTORS OF THE  
PANAMA CANAL AUTHORITY**

1. Be proactive regarding safety and health problems. Eliminate or reduce on your own the problems you detect or that are presented or pointed out to you.
2. Participate proactively in the correction of unsafe or unhealthy acts and conditions.
3. Keep the safety log updated and in order.
4. Perform frequent safety inspections. Oversee the compliance with the plans and documents approved regarding safety.
5. Perform corrective actions and stay up to date in every issue and corrective actions related to safety and health at the work place.
6. Coordinate the application of general principles of prevention and safety.
7. Keep danger controls working effectively. Make technical and organizational decisions with the purpose of planning the controls for the different works or phases of work that will be developed simultaneously or successively.
8. Estimate, reasonably, the duration of the execution of the different works or phases of work.
9. Coordinate the activities of the project to guarantee that the workers apply in a coherent and responsible manner the principles of preventive action in safety during the execution of the work and, particularly, in dangerous tasks or activities.
10. Organize or coordinate activities related to the safety and health of the workers of the project, weekly presentations, and briefing for new employees, equipment tests, and certifications.
11. Coordinate control actions and functions of the correct application of work methods.
12. Adopt the necessary measures to insure that only authorized personnel can have access to the project.
13. The contractor shall undertake the function of person in charge of safety when the designation of a coordinator is not necessary.
