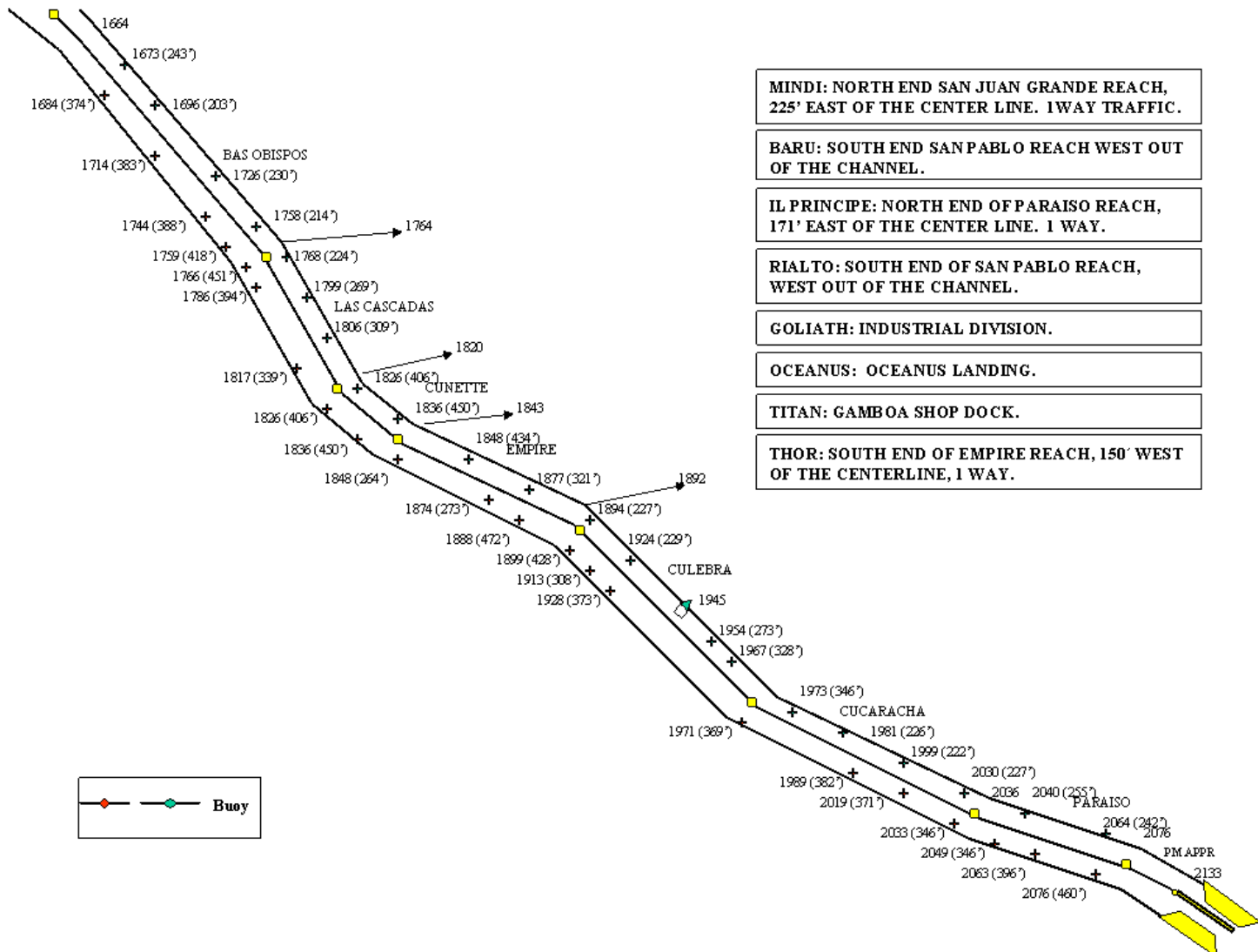

SLOW ORDER REQUIRED IN ORDER TO AVOID DAMAGE TO VESSELS BERTHED AT THE TIE-UP STATIONS.

SPECIALLY DURING LOW TIDES, PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES SHOULD BE OBSERVED WHEN APPROACHING THE LOWER LEVEL EAST SIDE OF THE LOCKS, SPECIFICALLY IN THE AREA WHERE THE VEHICULAR BRIDGE IS LOCATED. THIS STRUCTURE HAS AN A-FRAME BASE WHICH WHEN EXPOSED, MAY SUSTAIN SERIOUS DAMAGE IF CONTACTED BY A VESSEL OR FLOATING EQUIPMENT.
